

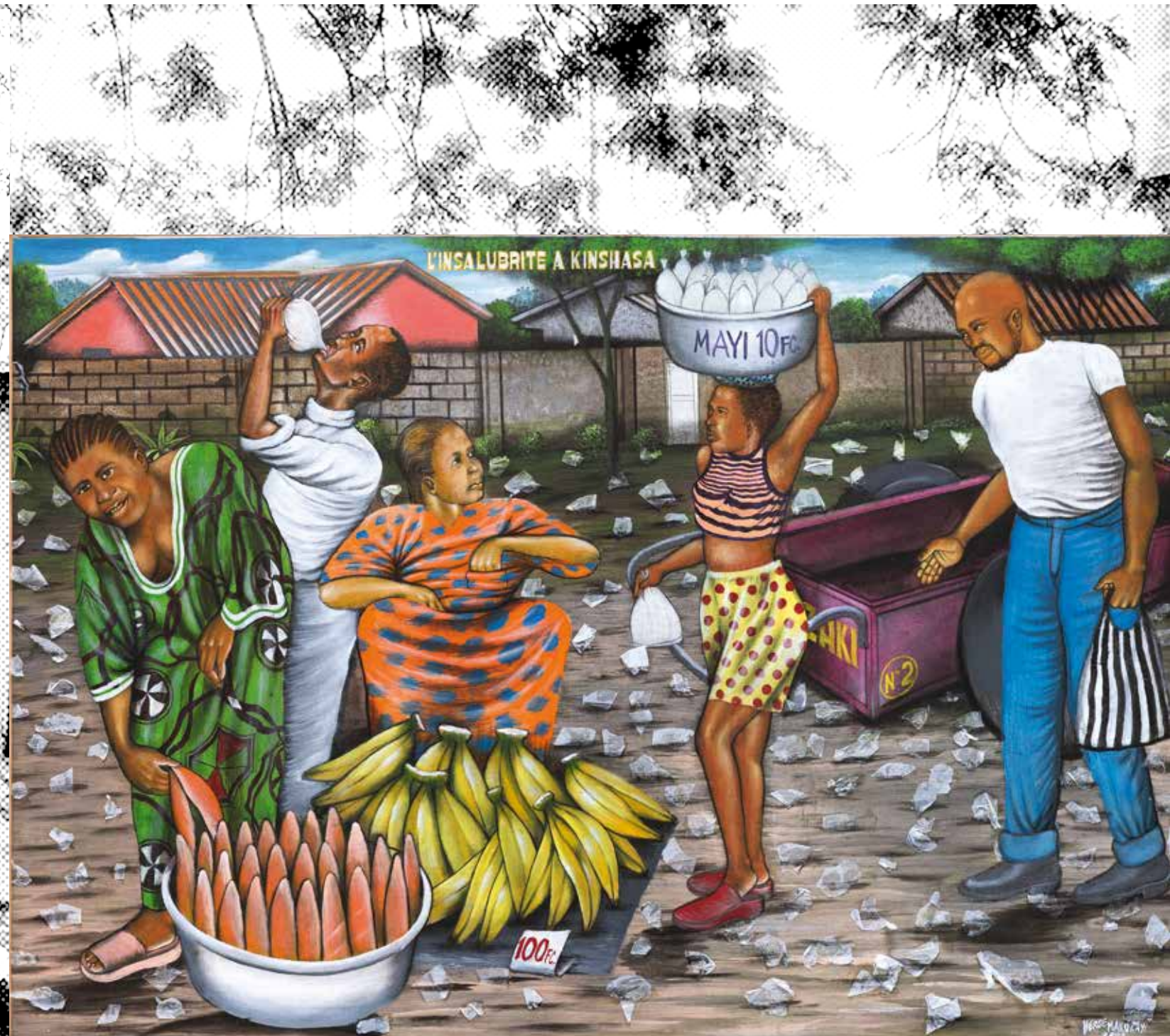
LACK OF HYGIENE IN KINSHASA
